MAKING AND RESPONDING TO REQUESTS

A. Making Requests

- **4** Could you, please?
- **♣** Can you?
- **♣** Will you?
- **♣** Is there any chance you could?
- **♣** Do you think you could?
- **4** Could you possibly?
- **↓** I wonder if you could possibly?
- **♣** Do you mind (verb+ing)? (it is like saying: Is there a problem if....?)
- **♣** Would you mind (verb+ing)......? (it is like saying: Is there a problem if....?)
- **♣** Would you mind if I (verb-ing)? (it is like saying: Is there a problem if...?)

B. Responding to requests

1. Accepting requests:

- Yes, sure.
- That'll be fine.
- Yes, of course.
- Certainly yes.
- **With pleasure.**
- Sure, don't worry.
- Sure, no problem.
- I'll see what I can do.
- **♣** No, I don't mind.

Dialogue:

Speaker 1: Could you please help me with this exercise?

Speaker 2: Yes, of course.

Speaker 3: Do you mind going with me to the market?

Speaker 4: No, I don't mind

2. Refusing requests:

- **♣** Oh sorry, I can't.
- **↓** I just can't, I am sorry.
- **♣** I am afraid, I can't.
- **Left** Certainly not. (for do you mind...?)
- **4** Yes. (for do/would you mind...?)
