

Introduction:

Education definition:

Education is the process of teaching or learning, especially in a school or other educational institution, or the knowledge, skills and habits that you get from this.

It's important for children to get a good *education*.

There are three types of education:

A. Formal Education:

- **1.** It takes place in schools or other educational institutions.
- 2. It's given by qualified teachers.
- **3.** It observes strict discipline.
- **4.** It uses systematic curriculum (textbooks, ...)
- 5. It's limited to a specific period.
- **6.** It's recognized in a qualification, certificate, degree or diploma.

B. Non-formal Education:

- 1. It's organized in a school-like setting.
- 2. It's not part f the formal system f education.
- **3.** It might follow a certain program.
- **4.** It's a second chance for drop-outs or those who didn't have a chance to attend school.
- **5.** It doesn't lead to a qualification, certificate, diploma or degree.

<u>C</u>. Informal Education:

- **1.** It's a result of exposure to the environment at home, society, daily work, leisure, etc.
- 2. It's incidental and spontaneous.
- 3. Bridges the gap between school and life.
- **4.** It's a life-long process.
- **5.** It's not limited to a specific time.







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
