What is a collocation?

A **collocation** refers to a group of **two or more words** that usually **go together**.

Collocations related to education:

Collocations	Examples
Educational background	You must have a good educational background in order to get a job.
Educational system	The government should reform the educational system .
Educational goals	Teachers do their best to achieve the ministry's educational goals .
School uniform	Most schools ask students to wear their school uniform .
Equal status	Nowadays, boys and girls are on equal status .
Equal opportunity	Students should be given equal opportunities in class.
Equal rights	Boys and girls have equal rights to go to school.
Higher education	One should finish their higher education before they look for a job.
University graduate	Sana finished her studies and she is now a university graduate .
University degree	Samir has studied for two years in Ibn Zohr and has just received his first university degree .
Free access	With free access to WIFI, students can use their laptops and phones.
Free classes	The government provides free classes to students until the age of 16.
Learning needs	Students have different learning needs .
Gender discrimination	When classes are mixed, gender discrimination gradually disappears.
Mixed classes	Mixed classes is a key to get rid of gender discrimination.
Cultural background	People's views differ according to their cultural background .
Adult illiteracy	Adult illiteracy is a big challenge to developing countries.
Adult literacy	Adult literacy is a window to development and prosperity.
Rural poverty	Rural poverty is the main cause of dropping out of school.
Basic education	The first six years of schooling aimed at providing basic education .
Boarding school	Students in rural areas usually study in boarding schools .
Civic education	Civic education enables students to know their rights and responsibilities.
Vocational education	Vocational training helps people work in different job.
